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Expert Witness Hourly Fee Schedule for 2026

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Initial Non-Refundable Retainer:

- **\$2,100** representing up to 3 hours of document review and phone consultation.
- Engagement begins upon receipt of the retainer

Hourly Fee Schedule:

- **\$700/hour** for Review of medical records and case material (beyond initial retainer); Preparation of report and any revisions; Telephone/Email Consultation; Testimony Preparation
- Billed in 15-minute increments.
- Priority (≤ 14 business days) turnaround billed at 1.5x standard rate

Deposition Testimony:

- **\$850/hour**, with 4-hour minimum
- **\$3,400** retainer, due 4 weeks prior to tentatively scheduled deposition date
- Out-of-town depositions **\$6,800/day**

Attendance/Testimony at Trial:

- **\$8,000/day**, full-day rate regardless of duration
- **\$8,000** retainer, due 4 weeks prior to tentatively scheduled trial date
- Travel days (beyond Boston, MA area): **\$4,000/day** when departure required before 5:00pm the day prior, or return after 10:00PM the day of trial

Travel, Lodging, & Expenses:

- All deposition/trial time is portal to portal, including any travel or wait time.
- Reimbursed at actual cost
- Air/rail: Refundable first-class (or business class if otherwise unavailable)
- Lodging and meals: Reasonable business-class accommodations

Cancellation Policy:

- If ≥ 7 days prior: 50% refund of retainer fees
- If < 7 days prior: No refund

Invoicing & Payment:

- Invoiced monthly or at completion of substantive work
- Net 30 payment terms
- 1.5% monthly interest on overdue balances
- Reports, depositions, or trial appearances may be delayed until outstanding balances fully paid
- Retaining attorney is responsible for securing full payment, including from co-counsel or other parties
