*Dr. Megally was born and raised in Egypt. He attended Cairo University Medical School where he graduated as an M.D. with Honors at the age of Twenty two years old. He immediately continued his post-graduate studies to become a surgeon and became a diplomat of surgery. In 1969 he came to the United States where he joined St. Clare's Hospital under the chairmanship of John L. Madden and continued his training and education in surgery. (John L. Madden introduced the Modality of Modified Radical Mastectomy for treatment of Breast Cancer to the world).*

*Dr. Megally has been certified three times by the American Board of Surgery and has also been certified by the American Board of Laser Surgery. He is an active member of the College of American Surgeons, the International College of Surgeons as well as many other surgical societies. He has received several awards for his efforts and dedication.*

*In 1976 Dr. Megally started his private practice in surgery with his main interests in the treatment of Breast Cancer and he continues to do so to the present time. During this ample time he was a member of the American Cancer Society, Manhattan division where he was for many years serving on the Breast Cancer task force as well as the public educating committee. He volunteered his skills and professionalism to serve the community, especially the less fortunate.*

*Twenty years ago he formed a coalition with fellow physician's whom all specialized in diagnosing and treating Breast Cancer, Astoria Breast Cancer Detection Center was born which is still serving the Astoria community and near by geographical areas.
