## JOB DUTIES & CARE RESPONSIBILITIES

**Triage:** Utilize MFTI for triaging acuity, head to toe assessments, electronic fetal monitoring proficiency, nonstress tests, contraction stress tests, external cephalic versions, glucose tolerance testing, lab draws, infusions, kidney stone and gall stone care, pyelonephritis, pain management, complicated migraines, perinatal mood disorders, MVAs, early recognition of preeclampsia, gestational hypertension and chronic hypertension, care of multiples, efficiency in emergency cesarean preparation, admission of laboring patients, discharge and education of all non admitted triage patients, assess prenatal care for completeness and care planning, covid management, EMT transfer of care, care of suicidal ideation.

**Labor & Delivery/PostPartum:** Head to toe comprehensive assessment, natural childbirth, epidural care and management, IV infusions, lab draws, electronic fetal monitoring interpretation, polyhydramnios, oligohydramnios, gestational diabetes, type I and II diabetes management, insulin drips, preterm labor, tocolysis, cerclage, betamethasone, oxytocin management, expectant and active management of labor in all three stages, chorioamnionitis, hemorrhage and management with medications: cytotec, hemabate, methergine oxytocin and TXA, jada, bakri balloon, prep for emergency hysterectomy, velamentous cord insertion, placenta previa, vasa previa, accreta, percreta, increta, operative vaginal delivery, forceps, vacuum, shoulder dystocia, pelvic fracture, preeclampsia, HELLP, amniotic fluid embolism, asthma, sepsis, hypovolemic shock, TOLAC and VBAC, uterine rupture, placental abruption, singleton, twin, and triplet deliveries, induction of labor, catheter care, magnesium management, cholestasis in pregnancy, cardiomyopathy, autoimmune disorders, anesthesia complications, general anesthetic, amniocentesis assistance, accept transfer from home birth or birthing center, ABO incompatibility, intubation, blood transfusion, fetal demise and postmortem care, bereavement care, drug and alcohol dependence and withdrawal, STIs, sexual abuse.

**Operating Room/PACU:** Surgical prep, infusions, informed consent, surgical timeouts, surgical counts with scrub technician, cesarean complications involving damage to surrounding organs, foley care, vaginal prep, emergency intubation, anaphylactic shock, fetal pillow, methylene blue, malignant hyperthermia, JP drain, wound vac, staples, alexis retractor, anesthetic nerve block, traxxi, bakri balloon, massive transfusion protocol, emergency cesarean under local anesthesia, anesthetic complications and medication reaction management, cardiac monitoring, transfer to ICU or general surgery, surgiFLO, cytotec, oxytocin, methergine, hemabate, TXA, interceed, B-LYNCH, C-Hyst.

**Newborn:** Apgar scoring, head to toe assessments, birth asphyxia, fetal distress, neonatal resuscitation, intubation assist, therapeutic hypothermia criteria, fractures, neonatal code, meconium aspiration, low apgars, respiratory acidosis, metabolic acidosis, feeding issues, hypoglycemia, seizure activity, small or large for gestational age, blood draws, infusions, NAS scoring and drug dependency, injuries related to assisted delivery, subdural, subarachnoid and subgaleal hemorrhages, sepsis, medication administration, hyperbilirubinemia.
