Clinical psychologist with neuropsychological expertise; 14 years of experience conducting comprehensive evaluations across clinical, medical, and forensic settings. Faculty at Tufts University School of Medicine, where I teach and supervise trainees in neuropsychological assessment, psychotherapy, and clinical hypnosis. Trained at multiple VA Medical Centers and involved in weekly clinical meetings at the National Center for PTSD, developing strong expertise in trauma-related disorders and veterans' disability evaluations. My practice incorporates advanced training in clinical and medical hypnosis, supporting specialized assessments of suggestibility, memory reliability, undue influence, and psychological manipulation in both clinical and forensic contexts. I evaluate complex presentations including traumatic brain injury, chronic pain, somatic symptom and functional neurological disorders, ADHD, and functional cognitive impairment, and I conduct disability evaluations, personal injury assessments, and consultations regarding medical necessity for neuropsychological testing.
